Shrimps are small and slim. They have a shell on the outside of their body. They have ten legs and a tail.

Shrimps come in many colours: grey, brown, yellow, red, orange, green, blue, and multi-coloured. Some shrimp have no colour at all - so you can see through them. Some even glow in the dark!



Most shrimp live in the sea, but they can also be found in streams and rivers. You will find lots and lots of them in warm seas.



Shrimps swim backwards by moving its body and tail. They eat what food they can find on the sea floor. They are very good at cleaning the sea.
